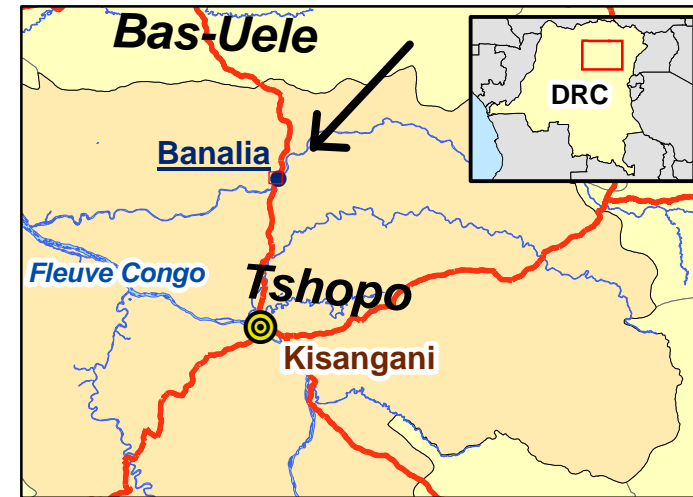


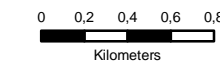

### Description

This map was produced by the G-MOSAIC Critical Assets Monitoring Service (CTA). The CTA service is monitoring the rehabilitation of the road 'RN4' in DRC. The results are delivered to the G-MOSAIC user OSFAC. The RN4 is connecting Kisangani up north with Buta, Dulia, Bondo and Monga towards the border with the Central African Republic in Ndu. Banalia is a territory in the Tshopo district, in the Eastern Province of DRC. The town Banalia is on the RN4, 120 km north of Kisangani. This map gives an overview of the remaining forest, the degraded forest and the cleared areas around Banalia. Automatic Image Analysis was performed by EUROSENSE.
